### About Wiltshire Wildlife Trust

Wiltshire Wildlife Trust was formed in 1962 out of concern for a colony of purple emperor butterflies in Blackmoor Copse (the Vaughan-Pickard nature reserve), near Farley. Today we are the only organisation concerned with all aspects of the environment in Wiltshire. We own or manage 37 nature reserves across the county and are also working to:

- Weave landscapes together to protect wildlife so that it can thrive and adapt to the threats it faces.
- Ensure people have access to wildlife-rich green spaces.
- Inspire our children to discover for themselves the wonder of the natural world and how nature provides for us if we look after it.
- Support individuals and communities to lessen their impact on the natural world.
- Encourage people to see the value of the countryside to their health and wellbeing.
