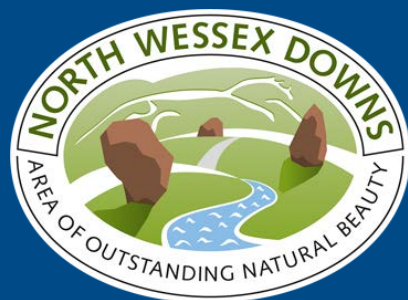

Jones' Mill is home to wildlife that thrives in wet conditions.

Can you spot the **great horsetail** plant?

In summer there are many different kinds of plants, such as the **yellow flag iris**.

At Jones' Mill you might also see **COWS**.

They eat the grass. If this didn't happen, the reserve would turn into a woodland.



The cows help to **maintain a rich diversity of plants**.



The landscape at Jones' Mill has lots of ditches and ridges. It was previously a **water meadow**.

Watercress was grown here for markets in London.
