



Wild Work Day FAQs

What tasks are involved?

The tasks vary depending on the site and season, but may include: Coppicing and bramble clearing, invasive species removal, pathway maintenance, hedgerow care and tree planting.

What does a typical day look like?

9:30 start arriving

10:00 Welcome to site, task briefing and H&S induction

12:30 lunch break

13:30 Tour of site

15:00 Finish tasks and reflection

15:30 End of day

What do you provide?

Gloves, tools and training. A member of the conservation team will be leading the group throughout the day.

How many people can you accommodate per day?

Depending on the site, we can go up to 20 but need prior approval for groups over 12.

What does it cost?

£750 (+VAT) for a group of 12, price on request for larger groups.

What does the cost cover?
